Act out The First Dreamcatcher story, based on an Ojibwe Chippewa Native American legend, then create your own Dreamcatcher using 100% natural materials including vines, leather, wool, cotton and beads.

Precious Memories

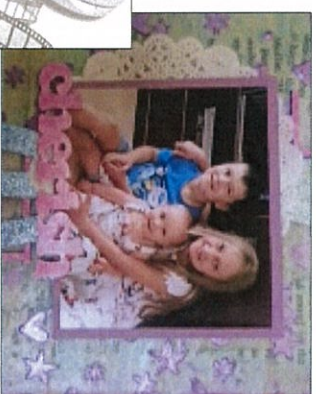
Using scrapbooking and marbling techniques you will decorate a canvas with one of your favourite 6x4 photos as the feature. Enhance one of your most treasured moments with this handmade keepsake.

Batik Wall Hangings

Utilising techniques from the traditional Indonesian textile art of Batik, you will use glue resistant dyes to design and create colourful textile wall hangings.

Flower Arranging

Learn the skill of arranging fresh flowers from an experienced florist. You will create an up-cycled vase to display their budding creations.



Film and Animation

Focusing on techniques used to create entertaining stories, either with animation or real life film, you will work in small groups to create atmosphere through camera angle, movement, music and sound effects.

Mixed Media Landscape Painting

Create your own artwork on canvas using a variety of materials and skills. Enjoy collecting, sketching, rubbing, collage, painting, cutting and gluing to develop a treescape inspired by the playground environment.

Drama and Improvisation

Harness your performance skills in this energetic workshop. Working in small groups you will create scenes, original dramatic sketchers, improvise and activate your imagination and creativity.

Beyond The Selfie

Selfies are fab but you and your iPad can do so much more. Learn professional techniques to help improve the quality of your photos on iPad, mobile phones and even the old fashioned camera.

Indigenous Art
