Children have planted koala specific trees; constructed bird houses and lizard shelters for our playground; filmed animal life in our playground; written nature poems; decorated a giant koala; created a video on caring for the environment; produced feral animal awareness posters; and have listened to expert presenters on caring for our area and the animals that live within it. They are very committed to environmental causes. Take a walk around our newly developed rainforest garden to see the results of this project and the hard work of Mr. Collier and Mrs. Edwards. It is a beautiful, peaceful area.

Still on environmental education, all classes will be involved next week in the 'Great Aussie Bird Count' where students will be observing and recording bird sightings in our playground for inclusion in the Australia-wide census of the bird population.
