### Principal's message

Dear Parents and Carers,

Our last newsletter for Term 3. This term has gone by particularly quickly, but once again we reach the end of a busy term. ### **National Day of Mourning**

Parents, please be advised that following Prime Minister Albanese's announcement last week that there will be a one-off public holiday for a National Day of Mourning for Queen Elizabeth II - **our school will be non-operational on Thursday 22 September**. This means that the school is closed, without teachers on-site and no classes. Students will need to stay at home.

### Out of School Hours Care

This week, I was informed that Hunter Mobile Preschool Out of School Hours Care (OSHC) will no longer be able to service the students of Gresford Public School with before and after school care. Their decision was based on the limited number of our school families currently utilising the service. Operations cease on the 23 September, 2022.

It is a little sad to say goodbye as they have diligently cared for our students for many years. Allow me to acknowledge the wonderful work of the team that worked alongside the school for many years. We thank the Hunter Mobile Preschool team for such excellent care and wish them all the best.

There will be a survey out today for families to complete regarding OSHC services required for 2023.

### **Enrolments**

Enrolments at our school are open and planning for 2023 is underway. If you know someone moving in to the area we would appreciate if you can encourage them to contact us so we can discuss enrolment options. This assists us greatly with our planning. Likewise, if you are moving on in 2023 please let us know so we can assist with the transition of schools.

### School Supervision

We have seen a significant increase in students arriving at school before 8:30. Supervision of students at Gresford Public School starts at 8:30 each day. Students should not be arriving before this time.

Entry Fees: Adults \$7.50; Concession \$5; Children 4-15yrs \$5




## Celebrate World Migratory Bird Day
